## Tackling MyCricket Online Registrations!

**STEP 1:** Go to the MyCricket Online Registration page. In the top right hand corner use the "Search MyCricket" box and select "Advanced Search" to search for the name of the player being registered. Make sure you are in the "Player" tab (not the Clubs/Organisations tab), fill in player details and click Search.

STEP 2: If you are a returning player you should have a MyCricket profile. Find your details and note down your ID.

**STEP 3:** If you DO NOT have or cannot find your name and ID, then go back to the Registration page and register as a "New Participant". If you attempt to register as a new participant and MyCricket believes you already have a profile, then you will need to contact me to have this looked into (see Step 6, providing as much player details as possible). This registration process will also automatically create a MyCricket profile. Your job is done! If you DO have a MyCricket profile and ID, and you have never logged in to MyCricket, or can't remember your password, then continue on...

**STEP 4:** MyCricket Registration requires an email to be attached to your profile. To check if you have a registered email, go to the Registration page, and under "Existing Participants", select "Forgotten your login details". Enter your Player ID into the search box and click send email

A link to enable you to change your password(s) will be emailed provided the same email address has been registered previously for the user account(s).
